

Twin Cities Tall Club - Tall Teen Scholarship Applicant Instructions

Read all information and instructions carefully.

1. Complete and sign the three-page application. Please type or write legibly. A separate document describing your activities is encouraged. You may also include printed articles, Web site URLs, or photos that help describe you and your achievements.
2. Attach a transcript of your records from your high school and other institutions, if applicable. This information will be kept confidential within the scholarship committee.
3. Write an essay about what being tall means to you. This essay should not exceed one typewritten page. Please consider typing your essay rather than handwriting it.
4. Give the recommendation forms to two individuals of your choice:
 - a. One must be from within your school community (teacher, counselor, coach, etc.)
 - b. One must be from outside of your school community (a non-relative adult). Please encourage them to include a letter of recommendation so that we can learn more about you and your achievements. Letters for college admission will be accepted.
5. All applicants are responsible for ensuring that the committee receives a complete application packet, consisting of the following:
 - Scholarship application (three pages)
 - High school transcript
 - Essay on the topic of being tall.
 - Personal recommendation form from someone within your school community (one page required; letter of recommendation acceptable, too)
 - Personal recommendation form from someone outside your school community (one page required; letter of recommendation acceptable, too)
 - **Note:** Individuals providing the recommendation can send the recommendation forms and letters directly to us, though we suggest you include them with the other application materials.
6. All completed application materials are due **March 20, 2008**. No exceptions.
